Steelwork

Standard specification as per our current Steelwork Price List plus:

- Steel front doors
- Steel rear doors & hatch
- 2 x pairs of engine room doors – 1 with hatch over
- Pigeon box
- 4 x low level hooded vents
- 4 x Anodes fitted

Engine

- Beta Marine JD3 tug engine
- 70AH charging alternator
- Calorifier connections
- Traditional hand controls to engine
- Propshaft, propeller, thrust dodge unit etc

General Specification

- Ballast laid on felt in wax-oiled bilges
- 18mm Plywood to floor on wooden battens
- Dried softwood battens & spray-foam insulation
- 4 x Hardwood internal door frames
- 6 x 11" Brass tug portholes
- 1 x 8" Brass tug porthole with star glass
- 5 x Brass mushroom vents to roof
- Front doors paneled and traditionally decorated – to include locking facility
- Fitted chimney collar on roof for boatman's stove

Traditional Engine Room

- Hull sides lined out in 9mm plywood
- Cabin sides lined out in softwood tongue & groove with traditional decorative mouldings
- 18mm Non-slip board to floor – removable to access batteries etc
- Full height cupboard to front bulkhead of engine room
- 2 x Pairs of side doors with inner lining, one with flip-over hatch
- 1 x 100AH Start battery – sited under the floor
- Removable boxing around diesel filler pipe
- Low energy 2D ceiling light with brass surround
- Inner lining and moulding to pigeon box
- Traditional controls i.e. push/pull and speed-wheels where applicable
- Scumble & paint in traditional style

Traditional Boatman's Cabin

- Faithful construction of traditional boatman's cabin to include:
- Drop bed with cupboards over
- Table cupboard with traditional drop down table & crumb drawer & storage underneath
- Traditional coal-fired range with steel hearth tray
- Ticket drawer & soap holes
- Low level ventilation in rear bulkhead
- Hardwood helmsman's step
- Shelves with feature cupboard over
- Porthole with hardwood liner
- Beam to cabin side & roof
- Double doors to engine room
- Storage under side bed
- The whole cabin to be grained & painted in traditional style with "Rose & Castle" decoration
- 12volt Lantern type lamp to side of table cupboard
- Low energy 2D ceiling light with brass surround
- Brass mushroom vent with internal brass trim
- Steel rear doors paneled & decorated in traditional manner
- Coal box/step
